Dates and Location

Camp will run for eight days, August 12-19, 2019. The camp's address is: Camp Young Judea, E989 Stratton Lake Rd, Dayton, WI 54981.

Transportation

Transportation to and from camp will be provided. The bus will depart from the **Cheder Boys Elementary, 5201 West Howard Street, Skokie** on Monday August 12th at 12:00 PM. and will return on Monday August 19th at approximately 6:00 PM. There will be a Milwaukee stop at the Good Hope Rd. park & ride off the 45. Milwaukee times TBD.

Facilities

The program will take full advantage of the excellent facilities of Camp Young Judea, which features expansive woodland, waterfront boating, zip-line, kayaking, canoeing, low ropes, tennis and volley ball courts, campfire sites and an air-conditioned recreation center. Fees
