No child will be permitted in camp without the full balance paid.

JEWSH PRIDE – ACTION CLASSES

Each morning we start our day with a short prayer session followed by *Jewish Pride – Action Classes*. Each camper is imbued with a deep sense of pride in their Jewish heritage. Campers explore through the beauty and value of our tradition through hands-on activities, stories, games and group discussions. One of the major themes will be Chanukah.

TZEDAKAH

Our camp develops a commitment amongst our campers to share with the less fortunate by giving a few pennies every day to charity. Please send a few coins for *Tzedakah* every day with your campers.

LUNCH

Campers should bring a clearly labeled lunch with food that will remain fresh at room temperature. Lunches must be either dairy or parve (neutral). Parve food includes vegetables, fruit, fish and eggs. No meat products are to be sent to camp. Camp will provide all children with plenty of water to drink and a snack. On Tuesday, campers will be eating a pizza lunch at Tel Aviv Pizza prior to the field trip and lunch does not need to be sent on that day.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS AND MEDICATION

If your child has any special challenges, conditions or food allergies please inform us so we may best address your concerns. Camp has a staff member dedicated to overseeing and administering medication, and dealing with health-related concerns. All medication to be administered during camp hours must be clearly marked with the camper's name and be provided in its original container. A separate note containing dosage instruction and parent's signature must be sent as well. Please call Rabbi Scheiman on his cell phone to discuss your child's health situation.

PICK-UP/ DROP-OFF:
